Oakland Cemetery is a non-perpetual care cemetery where the staff is committed to the maintenance and preservation of all lots and accessories. It is anticipated that visits to the cemetery will be made in a quiet and respectful manner.

Lot owners should feel free to consult with the Cemetery Staff regarding any item or clarification of the rules and regulations at any time.

SUGGESTIONS FOR CEMETERY VISITATIONS

1. Drive slowly. Speed limit 10 mph.
2. Feel free to use all walks and drives, but please refrain from trespassing on the graves.

Lot owners specifically request that all visitors please refrain from walking, skiing, jogging, driving, biking or otherwise trespassing on the privately-owned lots.

3. Look and enjoy, but do not touch. Rubbings or tracing of stones is not allowed.
4. All animals must be confined inside a vehicle (except for service dogs).

5. City ordinances and regulations prohibit:
 - visitation between 9 p.m. and 7:30 a.m.
 - speeding
 - bringing, causing, or permitting animals to enter the cemetery
 - vandalism of any kind
 - trespassing on the lots
6. Special use permits are available at the Cemetery Office and at web page www.icgov.org for all groups or special projects. Please make arrangements well in advance of need.

LANDSCAPING and DECORATING

Permission for permanent plantings must be acquired from the Cemetery Staff. Generally, it will not be possible to locate evergreen or shrub plantings directly on the gravesite. In most cases, a nearby location will be designated as part of a group planting, to enhance the entire area.

Live flowers in plastic or papier-mache containers are most welcome and may be used at all times. Annuals or perennials planted on the graves must be limited to a small grouping directly next to the monument or marker and must be tended by the planter.

Artificial wreaths, artificial flowers, and holiday decorations may be used at any time between November 15 and March 1. They may also be used for a period of three (3) days before and four (4) days following Memorial Day. After that period, if not claimed, they will be removed from the site.

Flags and emblems may be used for a period of three (3) days before and four (4) days following Memorial Day, but they will be removed and stored,

without responsibility for preservation, if still in place on the sixth day following Memorial Day.

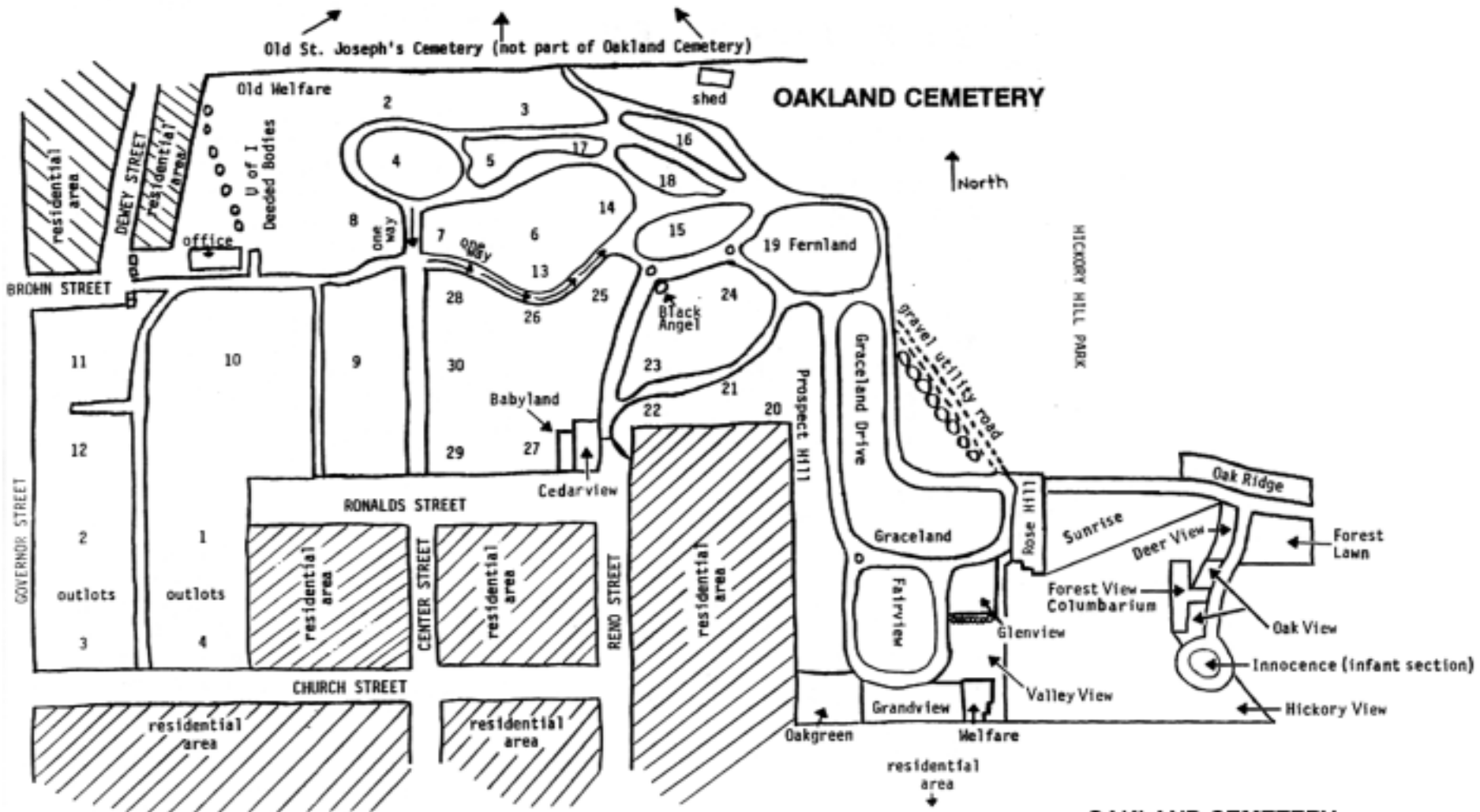
All wired flowers, glass jars and bottles, toys, cans, and other objects that might create a mowing hazard will not be permitted during the mowing season except as designated. When used, they will be removed and discarded without notice.
